Reading

- 1-uses prior knowledge, illustrations, and text to make and confirm predictions
- 2-uses knowledge of contractions, base words, and compound words to determine meanings of words
- 3-uses knowledge of prefixes and suffixes to determine meaning of words
- 4-knows homophones, synonyms, and antonyms for a variety of words
- 5-develops vocabulary by reading independently and listening to and discussing both familiar and conceptually challenging selections
- 6-uses a variety of strategies to comprehend text
- 7-uses specific details and information from a text to answer literal questions
- 8-makes connections and inferences based on text and prior knowledge (for example, order of events, possible outcomes)
- 9-reads aloud with fluency and expression from developmentally appropriate material
- 10-reads aloud with fluency and expression from developmentally appropriate material
- 11-reads informational texts for specific purposes (ie., task performance)
- 12-alphabetizes words according to initial and second letter

Writing
